ASSUMPTION CHURCH GREEK SCHOOL COVID-19 GUIDELINES 2022-2023

Please see below the Covid-19 guidelines we will be following for the safety of our Greek School students, parents, and teachers, even though the State of New Hampshire is not requiring any Covid-19 guidelines for school reopenings this fall:

- The first day of classes will be on Wednesday, September 28th for grades 5 & 6 and on Thursday, September 29th for grades 1 through 4. Registration will open on September 1st. All four registration forms will be available on our Greek School website at <u>http://greekschool.assumptionnh.org/registration/</u>. Please fill, sign, and date them, then mail them to our church along with a check for registration and/or book fees or drop everything off at the Assumption Church office (111 Island Pond Rd, Manchester, NH 03109) Monday-Friday 9:00 am-2:00 pm. If there is no one in the office or if you go after hours, please leave the envelope in the church mailbox. Please register your child/children by September 11th to allow for timely book order and delivery.
- 2. All parents will be required to sign a COVID-19 waiver when registering their child/children, along with the rest of the registration forms.
- 3. Mrs. Alexandra's classroom will be upstairs and Mrs. Ranya's classroom will be downstairs.
- 4. The class schedule will be:
 - Grades 1-2: Thursdays 4:00-5:30 pm
 - ➢ Grades 3-4: Thursdays 5:30-7:00 pm
 - ➢ Grade 5: Wednesdays 4:00-5:30 pm
 - ➢ Grade 6: Wednesdays 5:30-7:00 pm

We will revisit dance classes sometime in the fall.

- 5. Each student will have to bring their own snacks and water (<u>no sodas/caffeinated</u> <u>drinks</u>) from home. Students will not be allowed to use the water bubblers in the school building. We would like to ask you to please not send any snacks/treats to share until further notice. That includes, but is not limited to, birthdays and holidays.
- 6. We will dismiss our own students to the parents outside the school building. Parents will not be allowed to enter the building unless there is an emergency. Please drop off and pick up your child/children outside the front door. Also, please come and get your child/children instead of waiting inside/outside your car. As it gets darker earlier most of the school year, we need to be able to see who we are dismissing each student to.

- 7. Students will not enter the school building until the previous class has been dismissed. Parents should stay with their child/children in their cars or outside the school building until their teacher calls them in.
- 8. Each student will be required to bring their own school supplies from home (pencils, erasers, etc.) to prevent cross-contamination. School supplies will not be shared among students. Please make sure your child/children has/have their books, notebook, school supplies, snacks and water (no sodas/caffeinated drinks) with them on the first day of classes and EVERY week thereafter.
- 9. The use of masks is optional.

These guidelines may change at any point during the school year. We will constantly stay updated in regards to the state guidelines and keep you informed. For the safety of everyone, we still ask all parents to please keep your child/children home if they have any COVID-19 symptoms or are not feeling well. Also, please notify Mrs. Alexandra immediately if your child/children or anyone in your household tests positive for COVID-19.
